

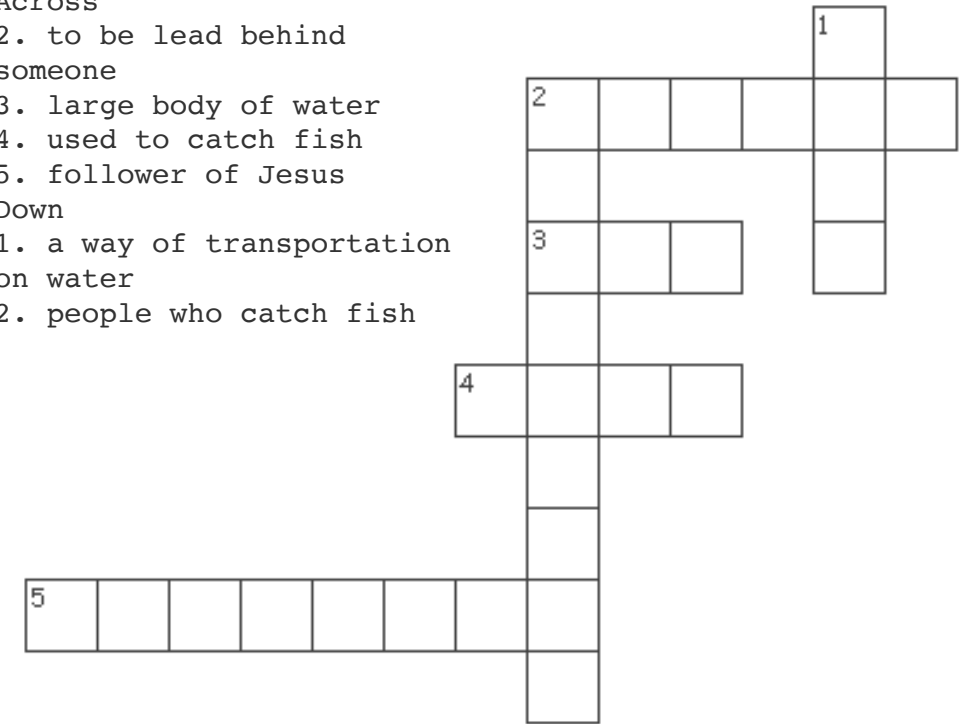
# Jesus calls us to follow him
