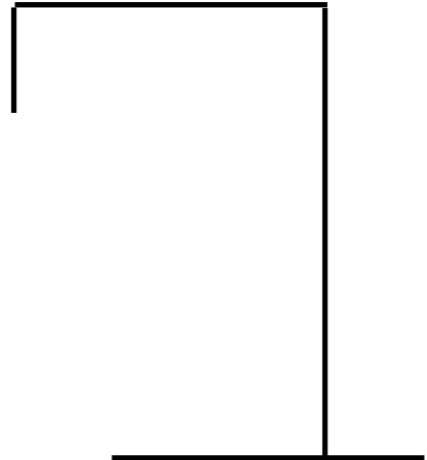


Play this game of Hangman. Fill in the missing letters to read this verse.

On the first line fill in Esther's fear. On the next line write a fear you have. Then read the statement.

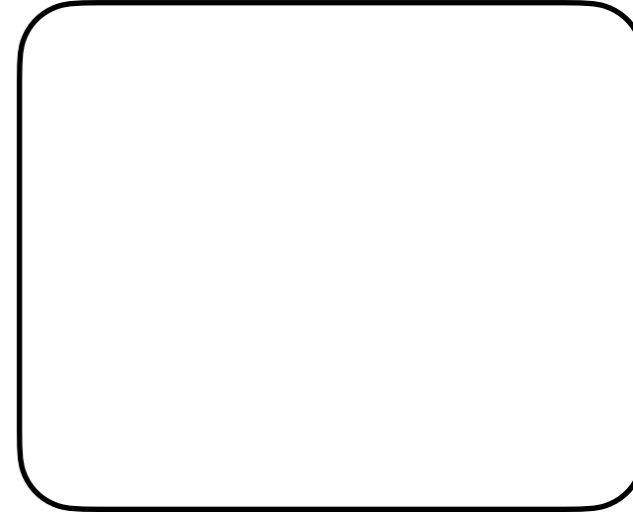
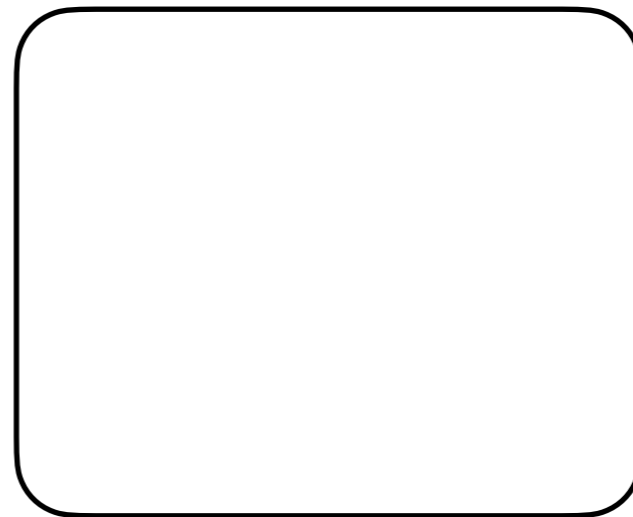
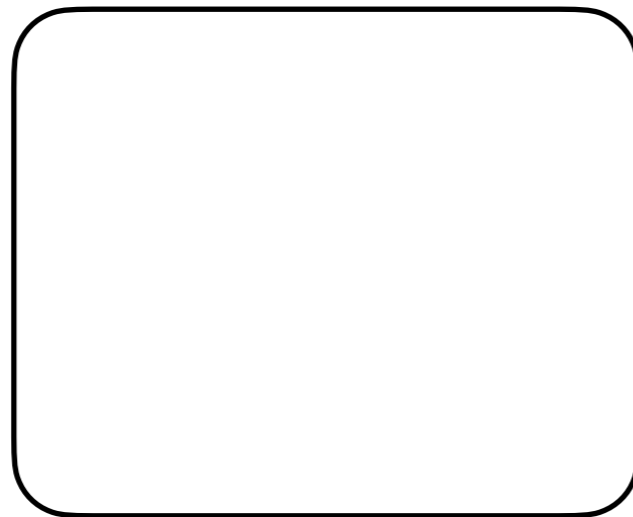
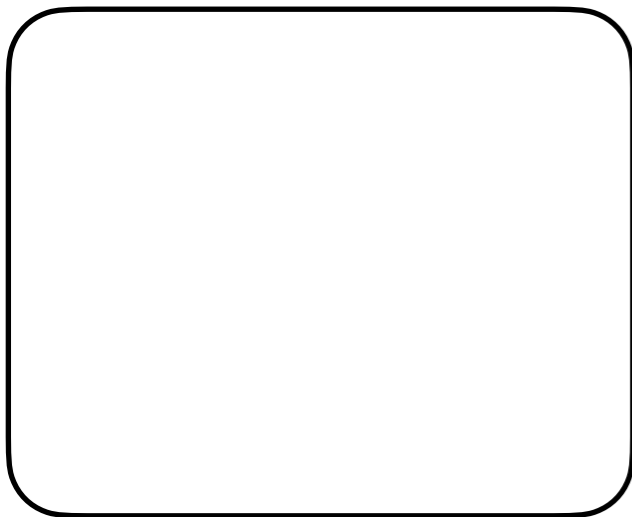
